District 7 Executive Board Meeting, Monday, October 18, 2021

President Alice Beers called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. at 7 Hills.

Present: Alice Beers, Jeannie Gregory, Janet Langemeier, Harlan Mathews, Carol Anderson, George Hayner, Suzanne Shapiro and Howard Harrell.

Absent: Tootie Chittenden

Alice called a special meeting to discuss the issue of wearing masks while playing indoor shuffleboard. She had checked with Riverside Co. Health Dept. who stated masks should be worn at indoor shuffleboard. The first week of league play it was reported that 4 teams did not wear masks. After much discussion the Board decided to send the following message to all Club Presidents and Captains on Monday, October 18, 2021:

--It has been brought to our attention that there are some teams who have played without masks. As you know, masks are required to be worn at all of our indoor league games. It has been decided by our District 7 Board that this cannot continue and the following rule will be in effect immediately. Any team who refuses to wear masks will receive a zero (0) for that game. Captains should talk before the game and make this clear to each other. They do not have to play if they are not in agreement about masks. The one team who is in compliance with wearing masks will receive 24 points and the team refusing will receive 0 points. If we learn that both teams did not wear masks, they will both receive 0 points for that game. If we don't have compliance, we may have to shut down the season. We are trying to keep everyone safe and play shuffleboard. It is up to all of us to make this season a success.

A clarification message was then sent out on Oct. 18th:

No team should be playing without masks. If one team refuses to wear masks, there will be no game. The team willing to wear masks will get 24 points. The team not willing to comply will get 0 points. If we learn after the fact, that two teams agreed to play each other with no masks, then they will both get 0 points for that game.
