District 7 Executive Board Meeting, Tuesday, May 3, 2022

President Alice Beers called the meeting to order at 2 p.m. at El Grande.

Present: Alice Beers, Jeannie Gregory, Harlan Mathews, Carol Anderson, George Hayner, Suzanne Shapiro, Howard Harrell and Jack Anderson, League Supervisor. Absent: Tootie Chittenden

Minutes of the January 4, 2022: Executive Board Meeting minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's Report: No report.

Election Process: It was discovered that the Board President cannot serve on the Nominating Committee. Carol Anderson and Howard Harrell agreed to serve this year on this committee. This year we have three Club Presidents who also serve on the D7 Board. A question was asked about this situation. Harlan stated this is dealt with in the D7 Bylaws-Article IV-District Board. Signed authorization must be turned into the District Secretary at the beginning of the President's Meeting.

Tournaments: Jeannie brought up the situation of players in tournaments looking at charts of how lanes play in D7 venues. Players are looking at charts on their cell phone or a paper chart. To be fair to all players, this practice is not allowed in any tournament and the player will be charged with a 10 off penalty. It was further suggested that the lane assignments not be posted so players will not know what lane they are playing until the ATM places the players at the beginning of the game. D5 is already following this practice. Club Presidents will be informed about this at the President's Meeting.

Next League Season Structure: Jack Anderson spoke about the need to start discussing our league structure for next season. Do we need to go down to 3 divisions instead of 4? Because of the number of players do we need to consider playing only 3 boards instead of 4 boards? It was decided a message will go out to Club Presidents to report in a couple weeks the number of teams and players they are projecting for next season. A President's meeting is scheduled to take place on Saturday, June 4th, at SDSE at 10 a.m. to discuss this issue.

Other Discussion:

Bonspiel: The Bonspiel Tournament at Hemet Muni is scheduled for June 6-8. Exactly 64 players are needed for this tournament. Sign Up sheet was available for Board Members.

Boyajian Award: Carol Anderson spoke about this yearly award that is given to two District 7 Shufflers at our Awards Ceremony in April. She is concerned that the attendance isn't as good as it could be at this event. This means winners do not get the recognition they deserve. This issue will

be discussed further at an upcoming meeting.
